IT security and the role of AI became vital for the debate about decision-making and security in a contemporary international environment. In the context of the growing use of algorithms in the decision-making processes, which is becoming increasingly AI-based and automatic, with less and less reliance on human resources, the issue of security positions itself at the top of the priority list of every serious decision-making process.
